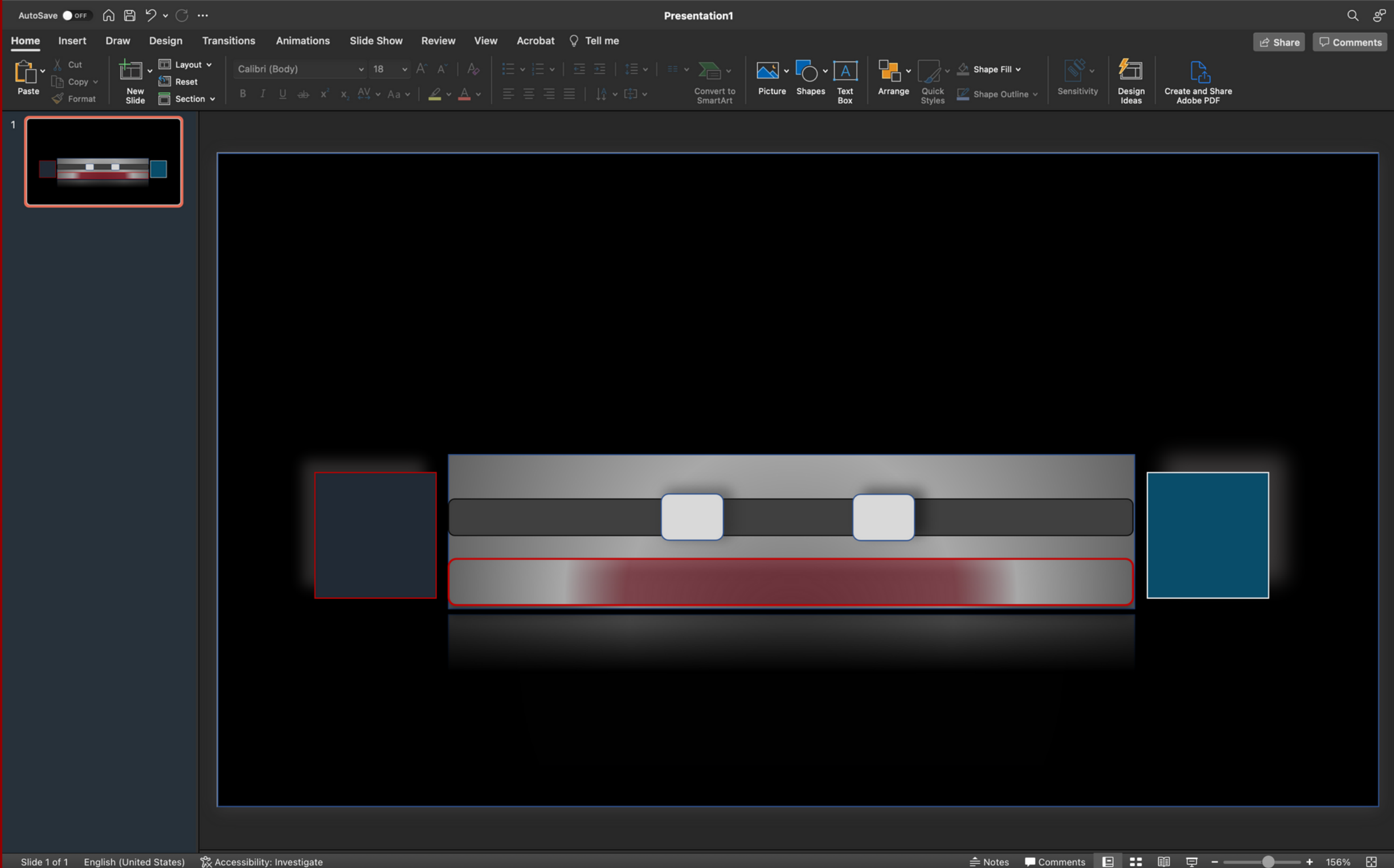

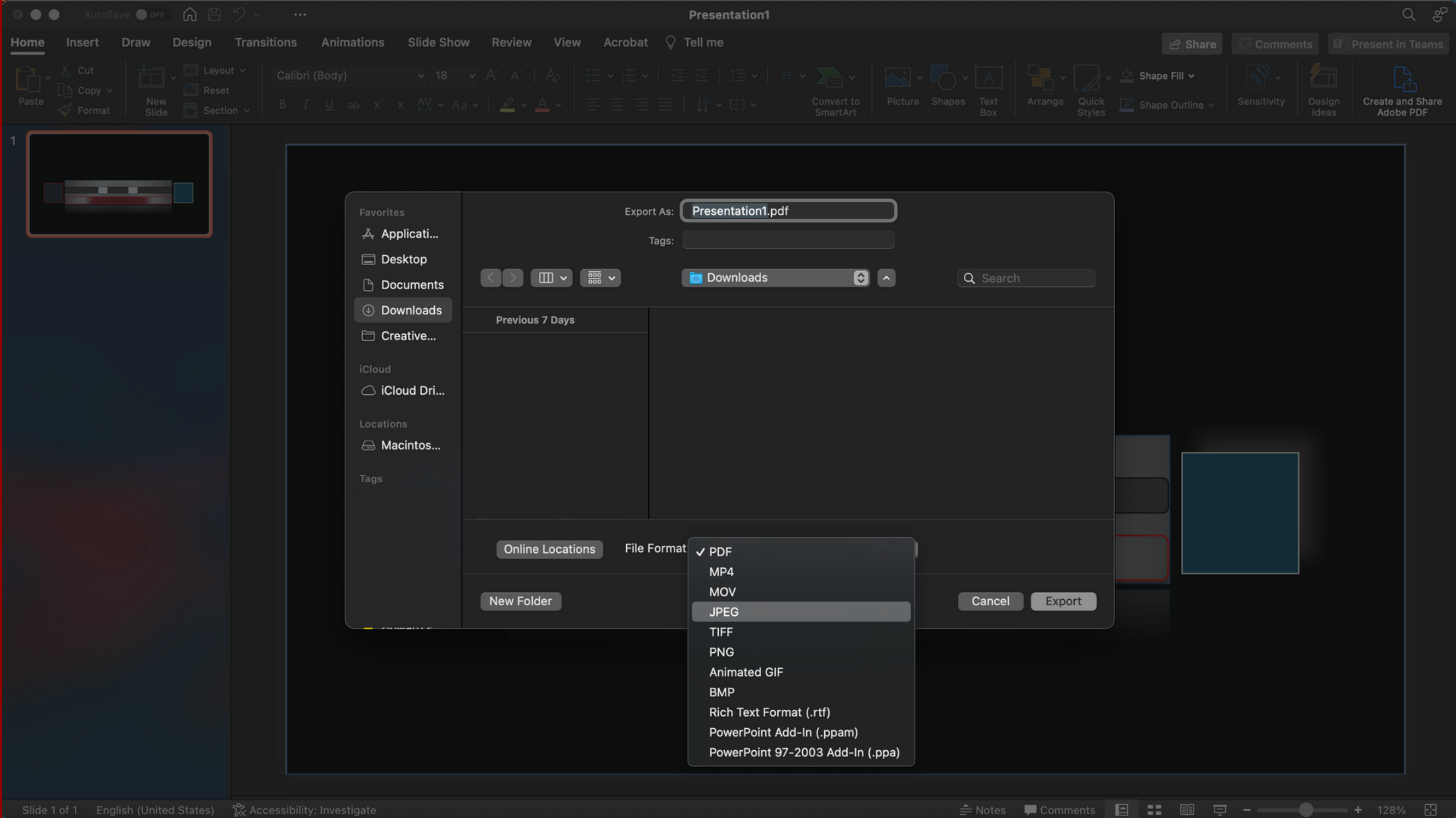
Getting Started

STEP 1: Using a graphic design tool or even something as simple as PowerPoint, create a dynamic background using shapes, colors, and more to fit your team's needs and desired look



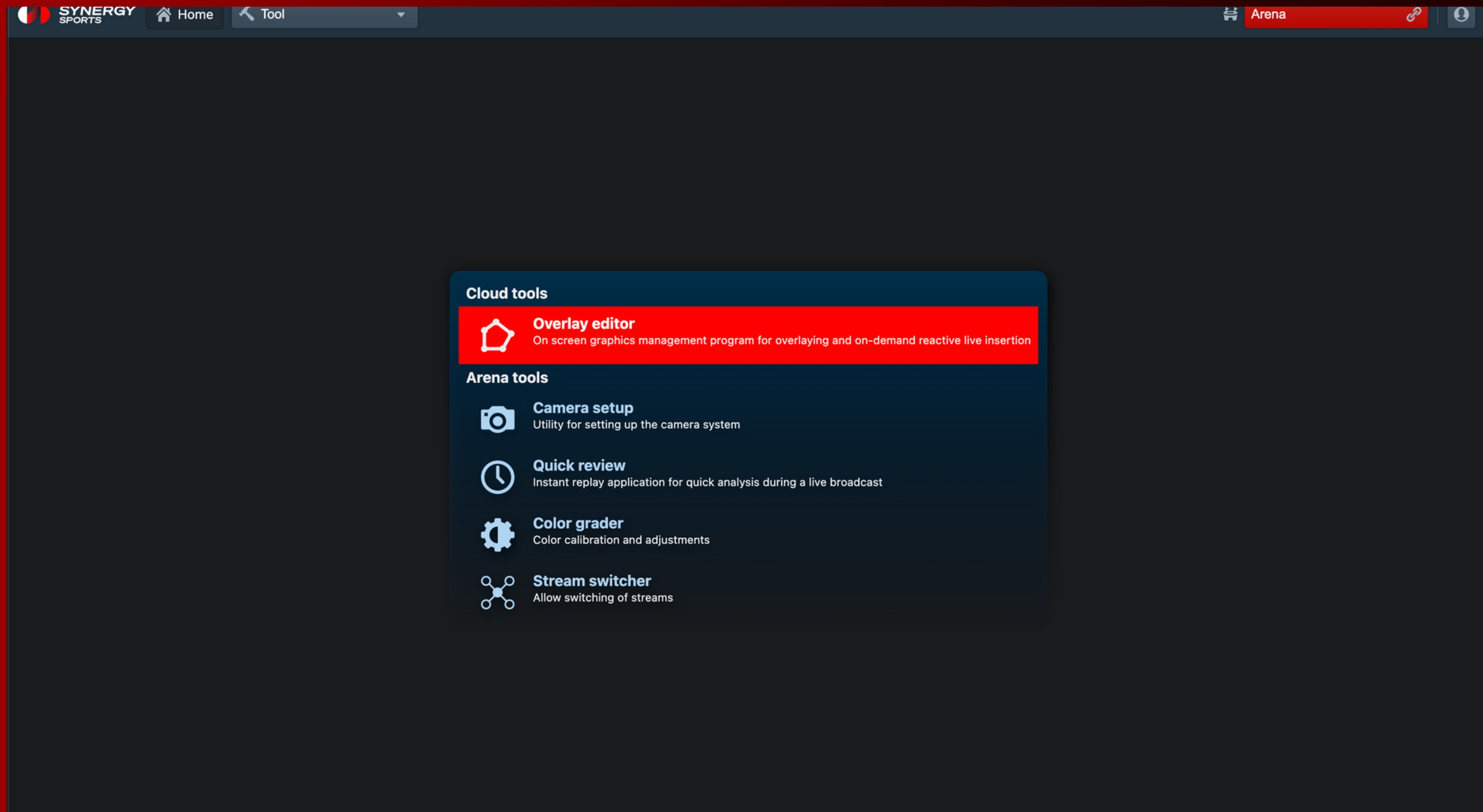

STEP 2: Export this image as a JPEG or PNG for use in the Overlay Editor tool



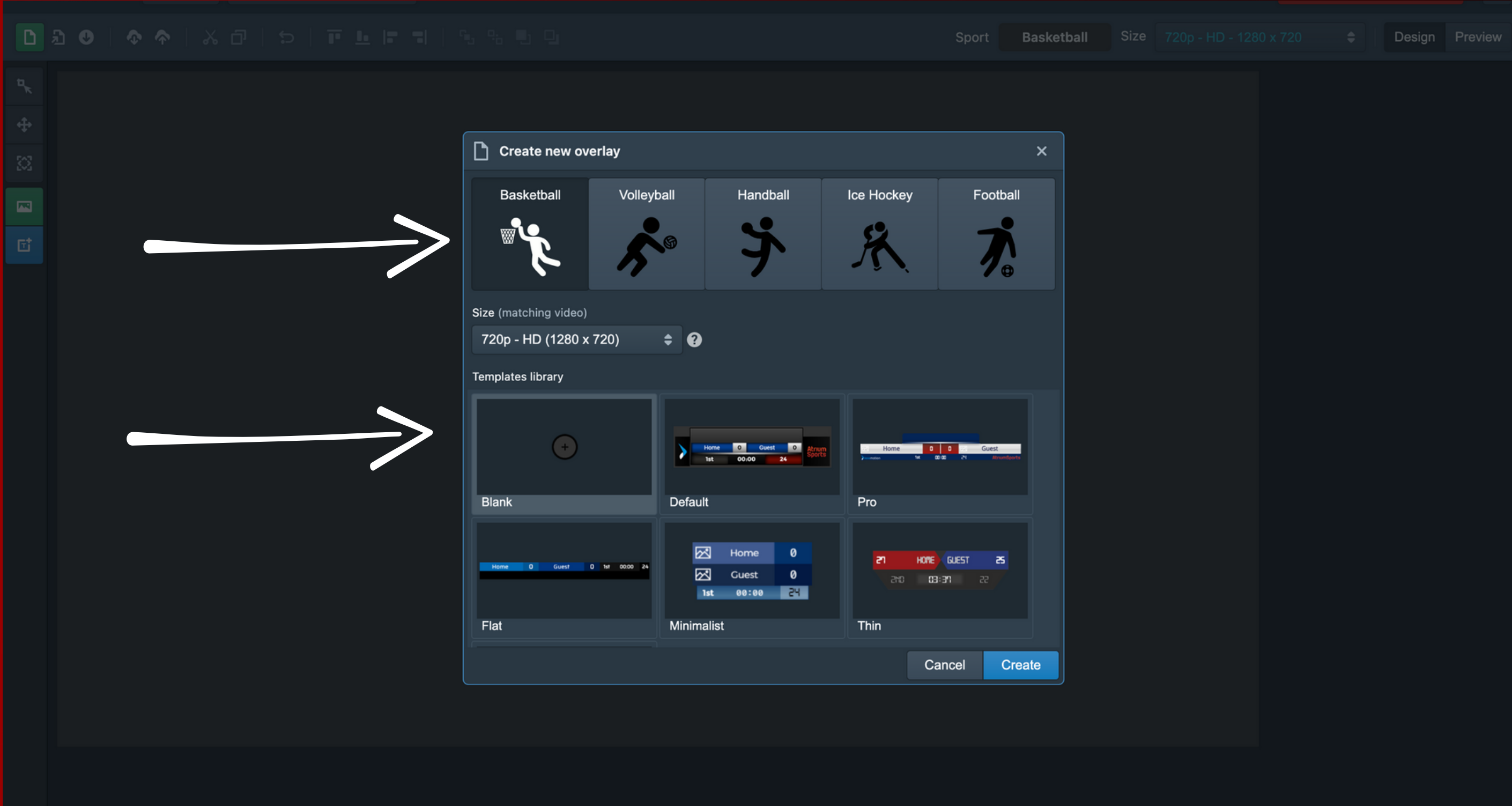

STEP 3: Log into the Production Studio and select Overlay Editor



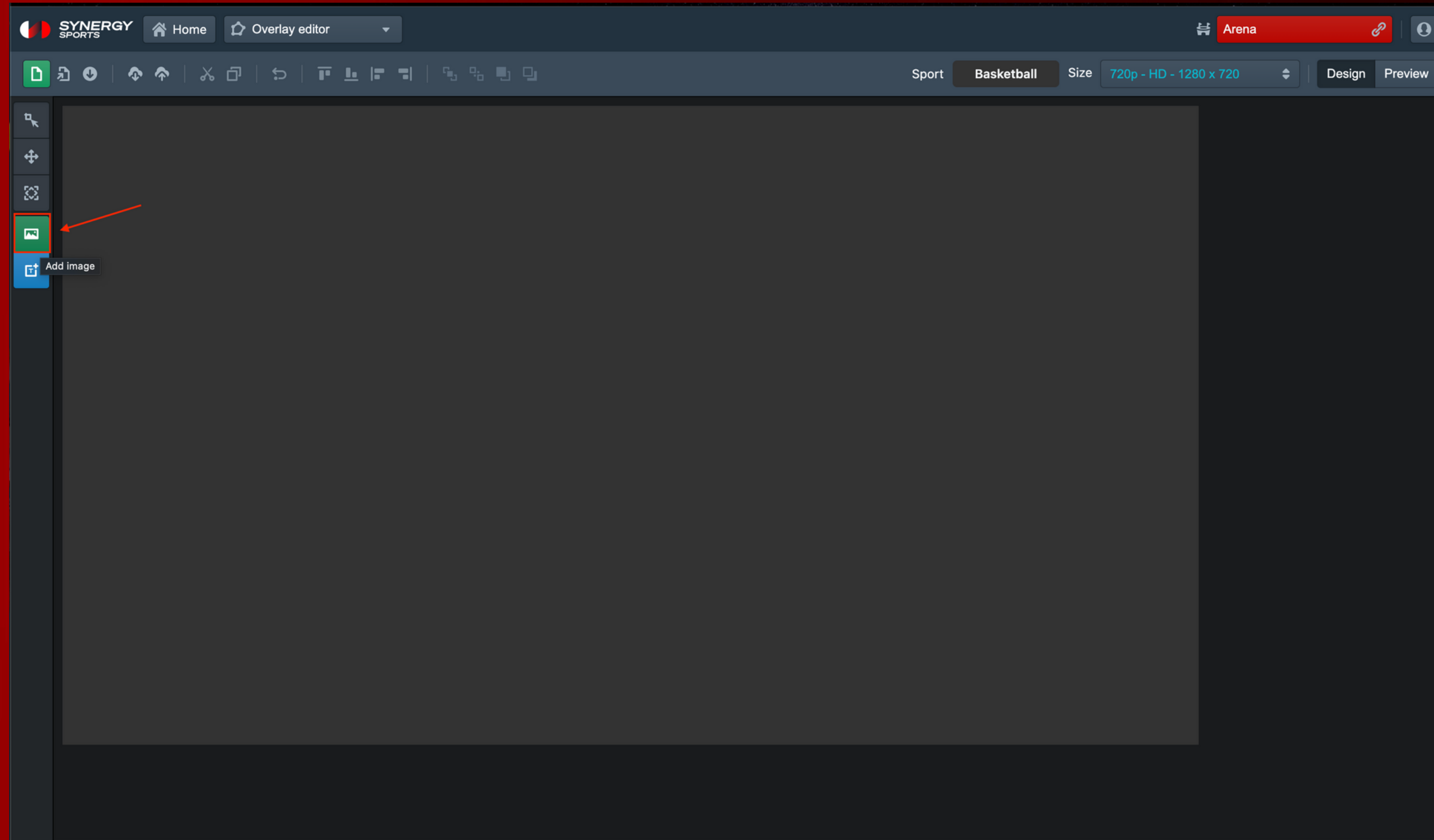

STEP 4: Select your sport and choose BLANK from the template selections, then click CREATE



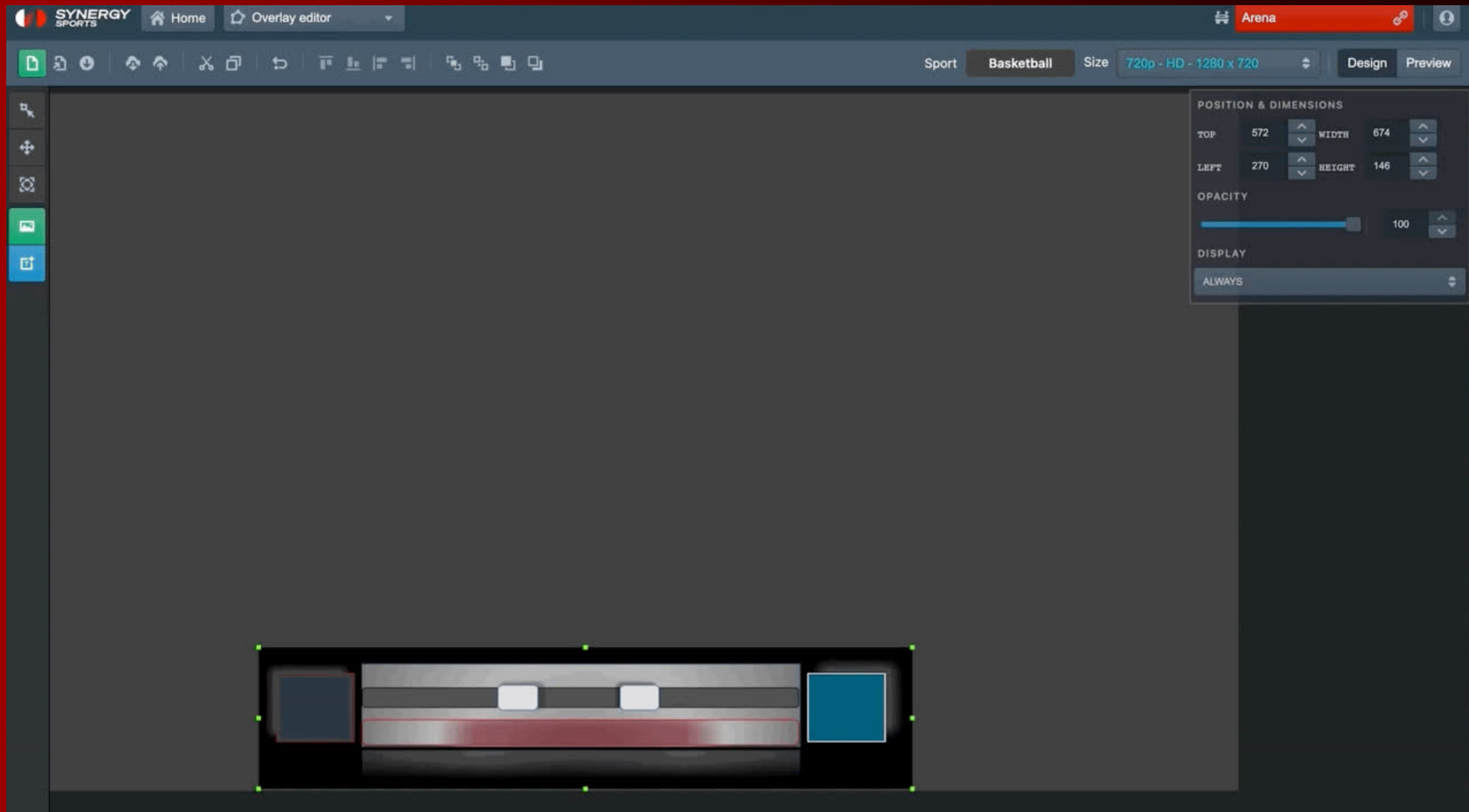

STEP 5: Click the ADD IMAGE icon

STEP 6: Browse for the image you exported earlier and add this to the workspace. You may need to resize the image or move it into your desired location. Then use the onboard tools to control how long its visible and under what conditions



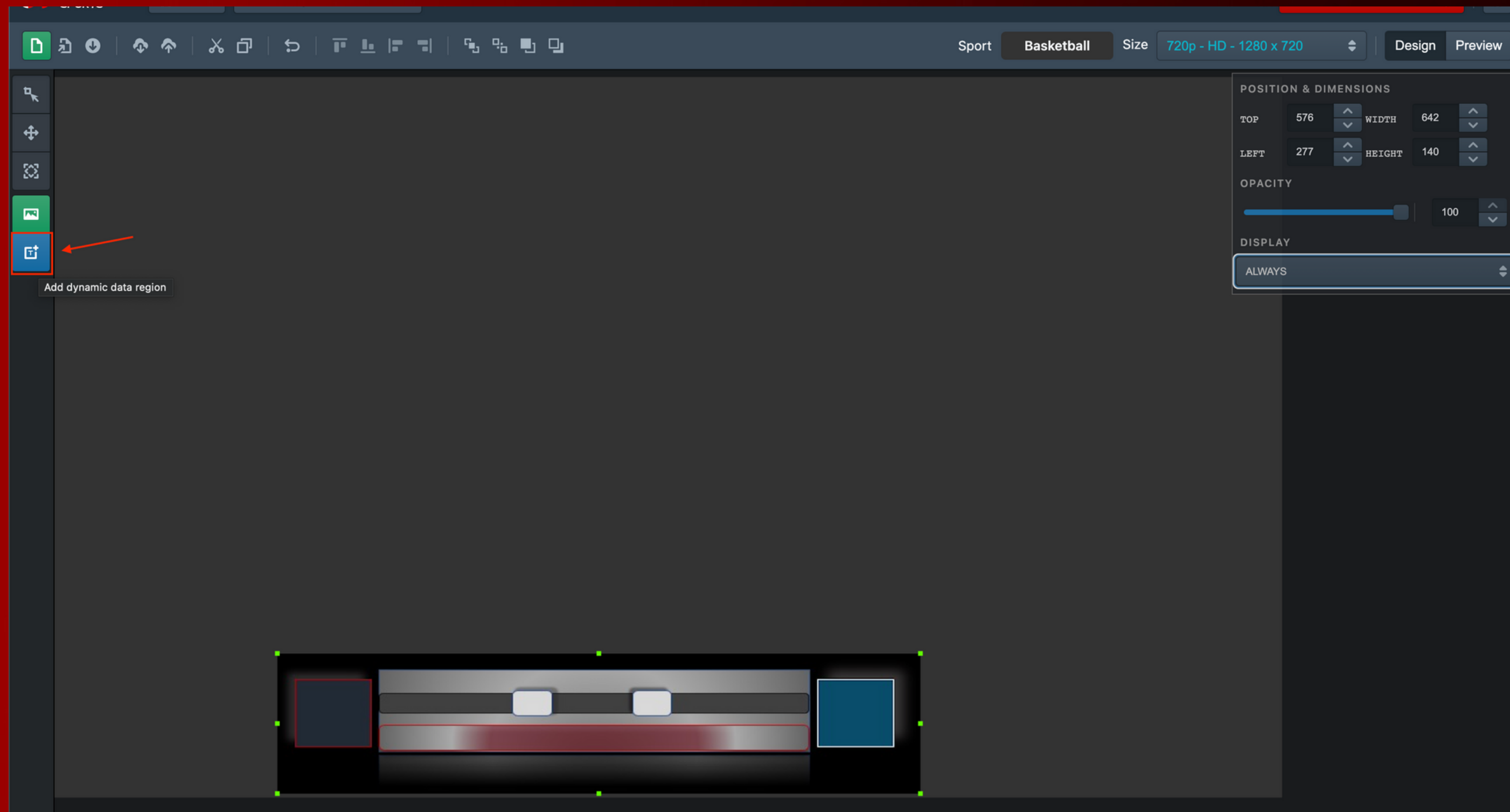

STEP 7: If you have additional images, add them to the workspace in the same way

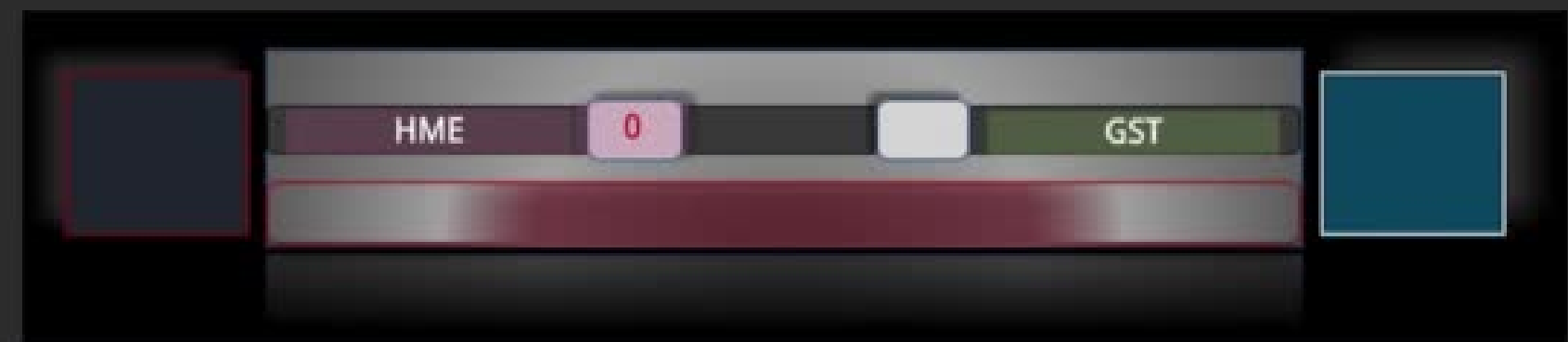
STEP 9: Each element has its own unique additional settings and tools that can be used to customize your graphic further

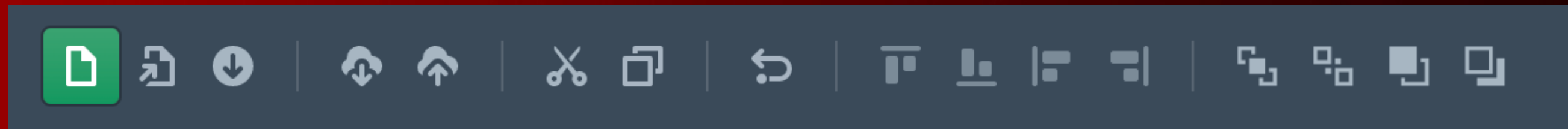
